Note. *** = $p < .001$, ** = $p < .01$, * = $p < .05$, ns = not significant. A higher total delinquency frequency score (0 to 24) corresponds to more reported committed offenses. A higher score on the well-being index (0 to 100) corresponds to higher levels of subjective overall well-being. A higher score on the primary goods proxy-items (1 to 5) corresponds to lower levels of satisfaction (i.e., more dissatisfaction). A higher score on internalizing and externalizing problems (0 to 20) corresponds to more symptoms. A higher score on criminogenic risk (0 to 42) corresponds to more criminogenic risk factors present and a higher risk of recidivism. The VIF values are based on the regression analysis predicting total delinquency with well-being, the 20 primary goods proxy-items, internalizing problems, externalizing problems, and criminogenic risk as predictors, controlling for age.
